Shipping information - important!

If you are shipping boxes to the Sheraton in advance of the conference, the hotel's conference manager needs to know the exact **number, size, and weight** of boxes you will be sending. Items you are shipping should arrive no sooner than 3 days before the conference. Should the shipment arrive before Monday March 6th, storage fees are applicable: \$5 per box and \$50 per pallet/skid.).

Please remember to **label all of your boxes with your Company name, Representative's name and cellphone number, and Exhibitor Table number**. You can find your table number on pages 5&6.

We have a template (below) to make sure your boxes are correctly labelled; **please use this template in addition to your courier's label**, as the courier labels don't provide the hotel with all the info they need (and are often difficult to read.)

For pickups **after the conference**, please label the boxes with the **pickup date** (as well as your return shipping label) so that the Sheraton staff know whether they need to store these boxes overnight.
